Academic Council approved a number of exceptional assessment arrangements in June 2020 to support students in the light of unprecedented disruption to learning and teaching due to the COVID19 pandemic. These <u>exceptional arrangements</u> were applied to progression and award outcomes in AY 2019-20. A separate 'fair assessment' approach' was applied to progression and award outcomes in AY 2020-21, in light of the ongoing impacts of the pandemic. Both sets of arrangements continue to be relevant for some students who were enrolled in those years, particularly part-time students.

SECTION 14 – POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH DEGREE REGULATIONS

14B.11 changes reflects the move to part-time PhD being 0.5FTE for 2021-22 enrolments.

14B.14 changes outline the different types of extended registration time – dependent on when students were first registered, and a section explaining the new 'thesis pending' mode.
