

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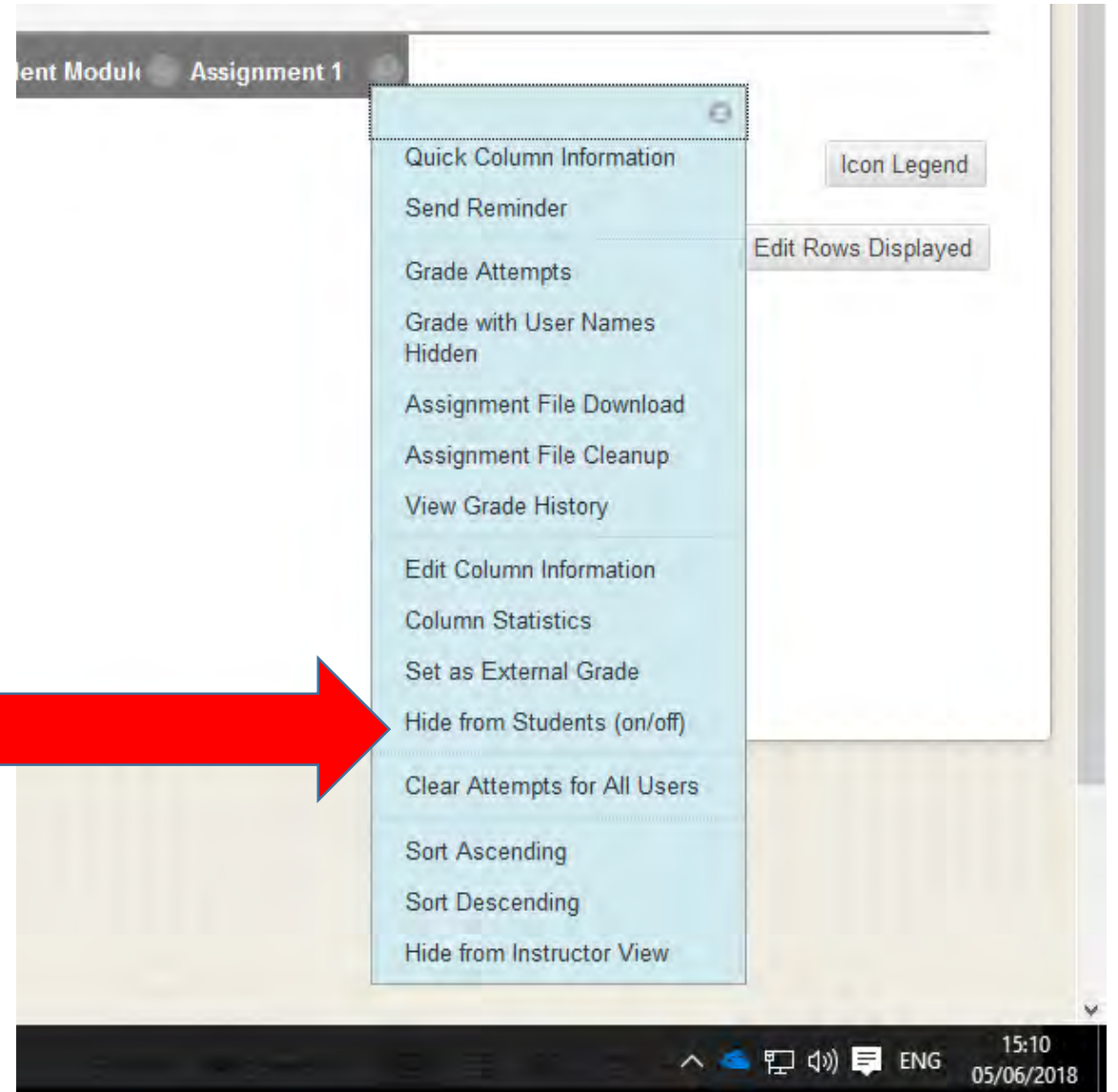
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Recording Assessment

- Use Grade Centre of Blackboard
 - Release grades all at the same time using 'Hide/Show' Function



Tracking Re-sit Students

- Resits can be held up for several years:
 - Suspended Students may return after a year's absence
 - MC can be claimed several times – requiring the Tutor to have an assessment available each presentation
 - MC and Suspension can return a student to a module which is no longer being offered in a course!
 - Tracking individual Re-sit students can be a challenge – who to expect and when?

Re-sit approach: Level 7 may be different from Level 9
